

## EuroTable X – version 3 beta 1

This **beta** release is only for MacOS X and in english. (soon in french and also for other OS as WinPC)


These informations come in **addition of current documentation for version 2.2b2 release**, (see <http://www.nelixa.com/registerware/eurotable/>)).

This new version contains new features for a better daily use :








### A full zooming of the main window.

Today screen pixels become smaller and smaller (for a better resolution) especially on new powerbooks. You can now choose the size of EuroTable (and all components in the window are zoomed) by using items of the new menu "display" . The window has also a size control in the bottom-right corner, drag the control until the window is the size you want it. Choose correctly the height and the width to obtain the right effect (height of text, visible length of string and numbers... )

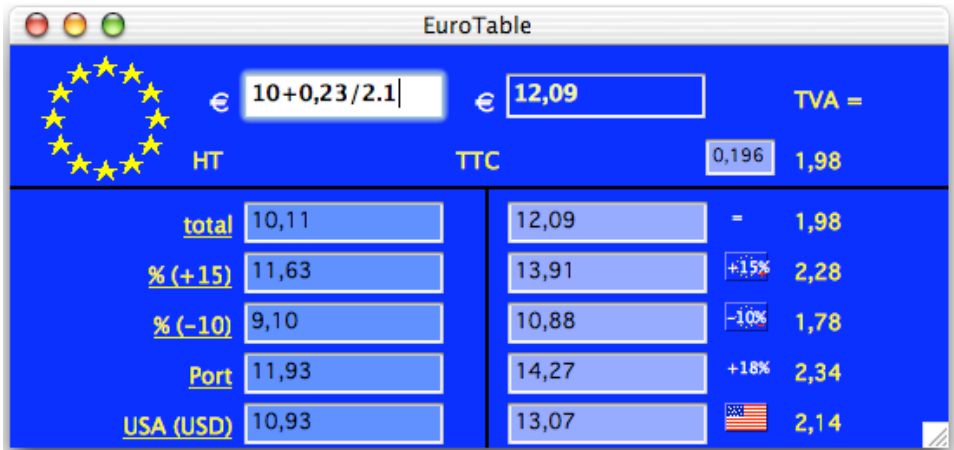

#### Euro, Currencies and Rates...

Progressively, Euro is only used against world currencies. (Euro-zone currencies are used only for value's memory). Now, in EuroTable list, it is possible to create special rates to display discount, margin with or without a flag.

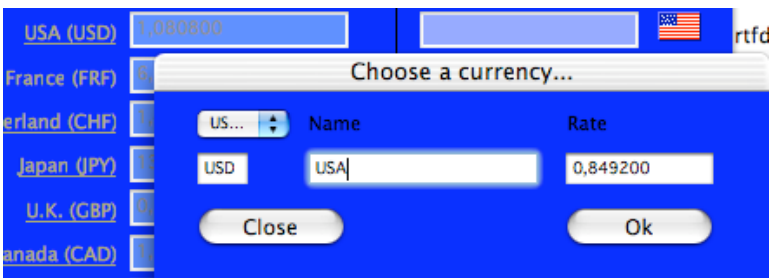


Normally, currencies are coded with a three letters ISO code (USD = US dollar). In this version, it is possible to create special code with + or - sign and number. As previously, the preferences mode must be activated to change currency (or pseudo currency) of a line.

Types of currency (or pseudo currency):

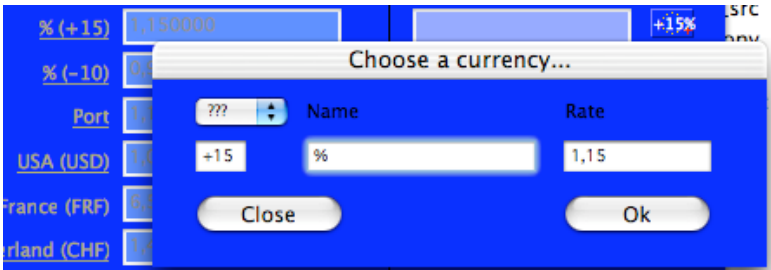
Old Euro zone currencies : FRF, DEM,... - rates are hard-coded in EuroTable and present in popup menu of "Choose a currency..."

World currencies present in ECB web page : USD, CHF,.... - rates updated through ECB web page if ISO code are listed in the ECB page.

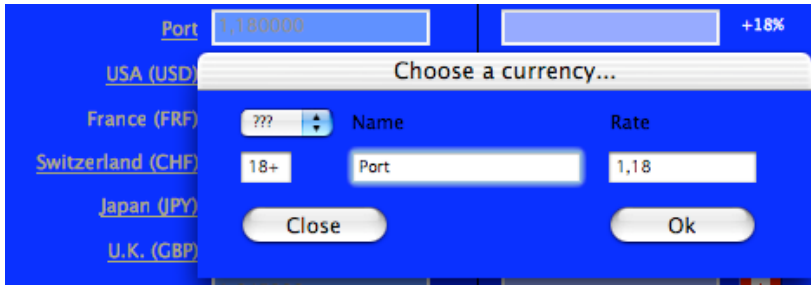


- World currencies not present in ECB web page "<http://www.ecb.int/stats/eurofxref/eurofxref-xml.html>": user must insert both ISO, name and rate

- Code beginning by + or - : EuroTable will search in the flags directory if a flag (icon) is present and will add a % in front. The code is added at the end of the name.



Code ending by - or + : EuroTable will only add a % at the place of the flag. No code added to title name.
